Please DO NOT Bring:

Portable stereo/radio, iPods, Cell Phones, Video games, Hair dryer/curling iron/straightener (plugs are not available) Food (it attracts pests)

Accommodations:

Campers sleep in provided cabents (cabin-tents) on our Wilderness Site. A clean outhouse is available on our Wilderness Site and campers will visit the showers on our Mainsite.

Activities Include:

Christian programming, archery, low ropes, lake swimming, canoe day trips, nature hikes, orienteering, wilderness skills, pond study, campfires, field games, and more!!!
