

Ryerson United Church Camp Job Description – Kitchen Staff

Requirements:

1. Must be familiar and in agreement with the Mission and Purpose of Ryerson Camp.
2. Must be available for the tenure of the position (this includes necessary pre-camp training, all summer sessions, and end of summer clean-up and debrief days).
3. Must provide a Police Record Check in order to be cleared for working with vulnerable persons.
4. Must have knowledge of, and/or interest in, basic nutritional principles.
5. Must be willing to work under the direction of the Head Cook and Assistant Head Cook.
6. Large group cooking experience an asset.

Responsibilities:

1. To be accountable to the Head Cook, Assistant Head Cook, camp Directors, and through them to the Board of Directors.
2. To work cooperatively with the camp Nurse to ensure that Health standards in the kitchen are maintained.
3. To ensure that the kitchen is thoroughly cleaned at the end of each day.
4. To ensure meals are nutritious, ample and on schedule.
5. To work within a daily work schedule around the preparation of food, serving of food, storage of food and cleaning of kitchen, on a daily basis.
6. To support the Head Cook in his/her duties.
7. To take part in other aspects of the program as required or as appropriate.
8. To maintain personal conduct that is consistent with Christian Camping.
9. To work alongside the other kitchen staff in accomplishing the above.
10. To invest yourself in the body of Christ as formed by the staff of people at Ryerson Camp while you are there.
